Chambers County Commissioners Court to Resume In-Person Meetings

CHAMBERS COUNTY, TEXAS – Chambers County Commissioners Court will resume in-person meetings and reopen these Court proceedings to public viewers on Tuesday, May 11, 2021.

"We are excited to invite members of the public to once again join us at meetings of Commissioners Court," said Chambers County Judge Jimmy Sylvia.

Seating will be limited because of the small size of the Court room. Admission will be granted only to the first 15 people to arrive. All additional people will be asked to wait in the hall and, if there to address an agenda item, will be invited in only when that item is being considered.

For those who wish to continue viewing Court proceedings remotely, a live stream will still be available for online viewing. Residents who wish to offer public comment may still do so virtually as well.

"We are going to continue offering live streaming and the option to participate virtually," continued the Judge. "This will help save space for members of the public in the Court room and accommodate anyone who may not feel safe visiting in-person."

In fact, Departments with items on the Court Agenda will be asked to participate remotely. If in-person participation is unavoidable, only one person per department will be allowed to attend.

To reduce the risk of spread of COVID-19, all persons who enter the Chambers County Court House will be required to submit to a health screening that includes a questionnaire and temperature check.

Face coverings are encouraged but not required in the Court House and other County facilities.

"As we move on to this phase of reopening, we ask the public to continue to partner with us and make smart decisions to ensure their safety and the safety of their friends and neighbors," said Judge Sylvia.
